# ROSE PLANTING & CARE

## Planting

Good preparation is the key to success here. The area in which roses are to be planted should be free from weeds and deeply dug with the addition of plenty of well-rotted manure and bonemeal. Soil that has previously grown roses should be removed to a depth of 18 inches and replaced with fresh soil from somewhere else. This should be completed in advance of planting to allow the soil to settle. Container roses can be planted at any time but avoid planting if it's extremely wet and frosty. Dig a hole large enough to accommodate the spread of the roots, and break up the soil at the bottom of the hole to allow the roots to go deeper into the soil. Mix a small spadeful of well-rotted manure in the bottom of the hole to provide nutrients for the soil. Apply mycorrhizal fungi to the bottom and the sides of the hole as this will aid root development.

Before removing the rose from its pot, water it generously. Remember to remove the pot and try not to disturb the root ball too much. Place a few handfuls of planting mixture over the roots. Replace the rest of the soil and firm down well, if dry conditions prevail then water well. No pruning is required in the first year after planting.

## Maintenance

Roses, like other plants, have basic requirements for survival, namely adequate light, heat, water and nutrition. Insufficient of any of these will put the plants under stress and this is when disease and poor growth result. Try to plant in open sunny positions; some roses will tolerate partial shade but most do better when not in shade. It is very important the roses get sufficiently watered in the first few years and a good drenching during very hot spells is often required. Mulching with well-rotted manure or garden compost in early spring and the application of fertilizer in March and June should satisfy the plants nutritional requirements. Should pests such as aphids or leaf rolling sawfly be active then spraying with an insecticide might be necessary. Diseases such as mildew, blackspot and rust are best prevented by good husbandry. Spraying with a fungicide is also recommended and it is best to alternate two different sprays at fortnightly intervals.

## Pruning

Always prune old fashioned roses in late February or early March after planting. Thereafter only prune after flowering to tidy the bush by removing dead or unhealthy wood, or to reduce size. Never prune in hard weather.

Always take out any dead, diseased or crossing wood first and then follow the pruning guide below.

Remove spent blooms throughout the season to encourage new growth.

## Alba

Alba require little pruning except for the removal of very old wood once established (after flowering) and perhaps the shortening of any growth by one third in February.

## Damasks

Prune summer flowering varieties once established by a removal of one or two very old stems after flowering. Recurrent varieties have their stems shortened by one third in Feb/March.

### **Chinensis**

Tend to make small twiggy shrubs if left unpruned. Prune each spring to encourage basal growth.

### **Bourbons, Hybrid Musks and Hybrid Perpetuals**

Prune by one third early in the spring to encourage new shoots and to prevent leggy plants.

### **Gallica**

Require little pruning apart from the removal of old spent wood once established and shaping as required.

### **Rugosa**

Prune only to keep in the desired shape, either hedge or bush.

### **Hybrid Teas**

Should be pruned hard the first year by cutting back to within 3 or 4 inches from the ground to an outward eye. Shorten the retained shoots made in the previous year by half their length, choosing a plump outward eye.

### **Floribunda Roses**

In the first year reduce the shoots to about 5 inches from the ground, again choosing outward eyes. In future years use common sense in preserving an open plant approach. New growth from the base made the previous year should only be pruned to the first good eye below a flowering truss. Two year old wood can be reduced by half and older wood can be eliminated altogether.

### **Patio Miniature Roses**

These roses often produce a mass of twiggy growth. After this unproductive wood has been removed, the main stems should be reduced by about one-third to a healthy bud or lateral. Remove entirely any over-vigorous shoots that spoil the shape of the bush.

### **Miniature Roses**

These are very dwarf roses, often no more than 25cm (10in) tall. Pruning is usually limited to the shortening back of any weak growths, removal of dead or twiggy growth, and occasional pruning back of older growths to near soil level to encourage vigour from the base.

### **Climbers and Ramblers**

For the first two years train strong shoots to the wall. Later when plants are well established, lateral growth can be cut back. Ramblers and climbers growing on trees are best left untouched, whereas for ramblers on poles or walls it is necessary to remove flowering shoots after flowering and tie in the new shoots.

### **Standard Roses**

These should be hard pruned the first year following planting and treated in the same way as a bush rose. Weeping Standards should be treated the same way as Rambling roses.

## **ALBA**

### **'Alba Maxima'**

Full, double flowers, blush-tinted becoming creamy white. Healthy grey-green foliage. Single summer flowering. Survives in very difficult conditions, tolerating partial shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

### **'Alba Semi-plena' (Before 16<sup>th</sup> c.)**

Clusters of large, semi-double pure white flowers with golden stamens. Lovely arching branches of grey-green foliage. Flowers form polished red hips. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

### **'Celestial' (late 18<sup>th</sup> c.)**

Exquisite little buds opening to transparent shell pink, semi-double flowers. Healthy grey-green foliage. Strong but tidy habit. Sweet scent. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor conditions and partial shade. Height 1.9m spread 1.2m

### **'Felicite Parmentier' (Pre-1828)**

Very pretty pale pink, flat reflexing flowers produced in abundance. Flowers fade to white with a green button eye. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Good healthy grey-green foliage. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Height 1.2m spread 1.1m

### **'Maiden's Blush' (15<sup>th</sup> c.)**

Blush pink, double flowers loosely formed. Healthy lead-grey foliage. An excellent shrub. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor conditions and partial shade. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.5m spread 1.5m

### **'Pompom Blanc Parfait' (1876)**

Small exquisite blush white rosette flowers born in clusters, scented with fine smooth foliage. Appearing late in the season, they flower a few times in long succession. Height 1.2m, spread 0.9m

### **'Queen of Denmark' (1826)**

Fully double quartered rose-pink flowers with crinkled centres. Grey-green foliage. Superbly scented. Single summer flowering. Survives in poor conditions, tolerating partial shade. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

## **BOURBON**

### **'Adam Messerich' (1920)**

Semi-double luminous bright pink. Continuous flowering and tolerant of poor soils. Height 1.5m spread 1.4m

### **'Boule de Neige' (1867)**

Double globular pure white flowers. Buds tinged purple-red. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Upright growth with good dark green foliage. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Bourbon Queen' (1834)**

Cupped rose pink, semi-double blooms. Free flowering. Vigorous. Can be grown in any soil. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Commandant Beaurepaire' (1874)**

A mixture of pale pink, mauve, purple and maroon splashed and striped across highly fragrant blooms. Dense, strong shrub with pointed pale green foliage. Tolerates some shade. Repeat flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.5m

**'Gipsy Boy' (1909)**

Masses of rosette-shaped flowers of rich crimson, fading to purple showing green anthers. Single flowering but offers orange-red hips. Very fragrant. Dense, graceful habit. Excellent in poor conditions. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

**'Honorine de Brabant'**

Large, double, cupped, stripy blooms in delicate shades of lilac with purple markings. Repeat flowers. Especially good in autumn. Good fragrance. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Kronprinzessin Victoria' (1888)**

A creamy white sport of Souvenir de la Malmaison. Fully quartered creamy white blooms. Very free flowering. Good fragrance. Ideal for small gardens or growing in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'La Reine Victoria' (1872)**

Globular, double blooms of paper-thin, shell-like petals of delicate lilac-pink. Very fragrant. Upright, arching growth. Suitable for a container. Perpetual flowering. Height 1.2m spread 1m

**'Louise Odier' (1851)**

A profusion of warm, glowing pink globular flowers. Very strong fragrance. Good for cutting. Perpetual flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Madame Ernst Calvat' (1888)**

Crinkley blush-pink large flowers with rich rose coloured depths. Red tinted foliage. Exceptional fragrance. Upright growth. Repeat flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Madame Isaac Pereire' (1881)**

Fully double purple-crimson flowers with paler reverse. Very scented blooms. Repeat flowering. Equally good as a short climber. Tolerates light shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Madame Pierre Oger' (1878)**

Very pale silvery-pink translucent cupped flowers. Sweetly scented. Good for cutting. Perpetual flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.5m spread 1m

**'Prince Charles' (1842)**

Large, flat, crimson-purple flowers that turns almost lilac as they age. The petals are veined and crimped. Strong growth with large leaf and few thorns. Little fragrance. Single flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

### **'Souvenir de la Malmaison' (1843)**

Named in memory of Empress Josephine's famous garden at Malmaison. Large soft pink flowers cupped at first but opening flat and quartered. Strong fragrance. Repeat flowering. Height 1m spread 1m

### **'Variegata di Bologna' (1909)**

Large, fully double cupped flowers of blush white with crimson stripes. Delicious scent. Tall with sparse foliage. Repeat flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

## **CENTIFOLIA**

### **'Chapeau de Napoleon' (1826)**

Fully double pure pink flowers. Interesting moss formation on the calyx, shaped like a hat. Rich fragrance. Single summer flowering. Good for cutting. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

### **'De Meaux' (1789)**

Short erect well-foliated plant with masses of small, double, pink flowers. Good fragrance. Single summer flowering. Disease resistant. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

### **'Fantin Latour' (1900)**

Large clusters of blush-pink flowers, opening flat with inward folding centres. Vigorous shrub with good foliage. Single summer flowering. Delicate perfume. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

### **'Petite de Hollande' (2000)**

Exquisitely formed miniature Centifolia. Flowers of pure rose pink. Strong sweet fragrance. Free flowering. A compact, bushy, very healthy shrub. Height 1.2 spread 1m

### **'Rosa Centifolia' (Pre-1600)**

Cabbage rose or Provence rose. Huge globular flowers packed with petals of clear pink. Lax shrub. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Tolerant of poor soil. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

### **'Rosa Centifolia Variegata' (1845)**

A striped form of Rosa Centifolia. A vigorous thorny rose of upright habit. Creamy white blooms streaked with pink are produced in abundance. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

### **'White Provence' (1775)**

Red flushed buds with long sepals, open to double blooms of delicate white with a green button eye. Very fragrant. Late summer flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

## **CHINENSIS**

### **'Bengal Beauty'**

A superb rose. Constantly smothered in light crimson blooms from May until frosts. A compact and bushy habit. Good in a pot. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

### **'Cecile Brunner' (1904)**

The Sweetheart rose. Shell-pink, tiny, perfect, Hybrid Tea shaped flowers, opening double and flat. Spindly short growth. Perpetual flowering. Slight fragrance. Good disease resistance. Good in a container. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Cramoisi Superieur' (1832)**

Small semi-double cupped flowers of bright crimson. Very free flowering. Slightly scented. Slender growth. Will tolerate some shade. Height 1m spread 0.6m

**'Fabvier' (1832)**

Double bright crimson flowers with the occasional white fleck. Healthy and free flowering. Well foliated. Height 1m spread 0.6m

**'Irene Watts' (1896)**

Very large, double blooms of blush-pink with hints of salmon. A short and compact plant. Dark green matt foliage. Perpetual flowering. Good fragrance. Good in a container. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Louis XIV'**

Dark crimson flowers full of petals showing golden anthers. Good fragrance. Continuously flowering throughout the summer. Strong shrub. Height 1.0m spread 1.0m

**'Mutabilis' (1880)**

Clusters of single flowers, flame to copper-yellow buds, fading to pink then copper crimson. Bronze foliage. Perpetual flowering. Slight fragrance. Excellent disease resistance. Can be trained as a climber. Tolerates shade. Good in a container. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**'Old Blush China' (1789)**

Clusters of semi-double pink flowers. Almost continuous flowering throughout the summer. Very scented. Will tolerate some shade and poor soil. Almost thornless. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Perle d'Or' (1890)**

Tiny miniature Hybrid Tea shaped buds, in pale apricot, fading to cream. Come in clusters on a sparsely foliated shrub. Perpetual flowering. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Sophie's Perpetual'**

An old rose of unknown origin. Shapely double silver and pink flowers. Scented. Continuous flowering. Virtually thornless. Height 2.5m spread 1.2m

**'Viridiflora' – The Green Rose (1855)**

A novelty or collector's specimen. Flowers of green, tinted brown, very unusual. Continuous flowering. Tolerant of some shade. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**CLIMBER****'Aimee Vibert' (1828)**

Graceful sprays of small, double, pure white flowers. Repeat flowering. Musky scent. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Glossy foliage. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Alchemist' (1956)**

A robust climber. Apricot yellow, very double blooms, with orange yolk in centre. Strong scent. Repeat flowering. Tolerates some shade. Height 3.5m spread 2.4m

**'Alibaba' (2009)**

A coral-salmon bloom set off well by glossy green foliage held on a tidy compact climber. Flowers well over the season. Good disease resistance. Suitable for a north-facing wall. Height 2m spread 1.5m

**'Alister Stella Gray' (1894)**

Clusters of tightly scrolled yolk-yellow buds opening to rosette-shaped creamy flowers. Scented. Perpetual flowering. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Aloha' (1955)**

Large, cupped flowers of deep rose pink, suffused with coral-salmon. Very scented. Perpetual flowering. Disease resistant. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Altissimo' (1966)**

Trusses of large, blood-red, single flowers. Slightly scented. Continuous flowering. Good strong growth and plentiful dark foliage. Height 3m spread 2m

**'Antique' (1989)**

Large, very full flowers of old-fashioned style, deep rose pink with darker centres. Continuous flowering. Lush green foliage. Vigorous. Height 2.4m spread 1.2m

**'Awakening' (1935)**

Fully double quartered form of 'New Dawn' with all its parent's characteristics. Continuous flowering. Highly fragrant. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Bantry Bay' (1967)**

Flowers are large, shapely semi-double to double, bright pink. Continuous flowering. Strong healthy growth and leathery, mid-green foliage. Height 3.6m spread 2.4m

**'Blush Noisette' (1817)**

The original Noisette rose. Clusters of semi-double, lilac-pink flowers. Richly scented. Repeat flowering. Healthy foliage. Height 3.5m spread 2m

**'Bouquet d`Or' (1872)**

Coppery yellow shapely double flowers. Slightly scented. Repeat flowering. Vigorous. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Bouquet Tout Fait' (1836)**

Pure white semi-double blooms with a muddled appearance. Flowers in large clusters, hips in autumn. Pale green foliage with a pale blue tinge. Scented. Perpetual flowering. Height 2m spread 2.4m

**'Candyland' (2008)**

Very showy climber with sizeable Hybrid Tea shaped blooms carried in huge clusters. Flowers of pink spun with creamy ivory yellow. Repeat flowering. Gorgeous glossy foliage. Vigorous, hardy and easy to grow. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Casino' (1963)**

A beautiful primrose yellow, large full and globular rose. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Suitable for a north-facing wall. Repeat flowering. Very fragrant. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Cecile Brunner' (1894)**

The Sweetheart Rose. Thimble-sized Hybrid Tea buds of coppery pink. Red stemmed foliage. Fragrant. Repeats. Will tolerate some shade. Height 7.5m spread 6m



**'Chris'**

Hybrid Tea shaped buds opening to full petalled flowers of bright yellow. Flowers fade to creamy yellow with age. Perpetual flowering. Scented. Very healthy plant. Height 2.5m spread 1.8m

**'Cinderella'**

Large old fashioned, slightly pendulous, soft-pink blooms in small clusters. Sweet, fruity fragrance of ripe apples. Continuous flowering. Large glossy foliage. Height 5m spread 3.5m

**'Compassion' (1973)**

Hybrid Tea shaped flowers, salmon-pink, tinted with apricot orange. Excellent fragrance. Good dark foliage. Repeats through the summer. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Creme de la Creme'**

White buds changing with age to deeper cream. Sweetly scented. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Large, glossy, olive green foliage. Height 3.5m spread 2.5m

**'Crepuscule' (1904)**

Double, shapely flowers of a pleasing mixture of orange and apricot. Light green plentiful foliage. Repeat flowering with some scent. Not very thorny. Height 3.6m spread 1.5m

**'Crimson Glory' (1946)**

Shapely blooms of deep velvet red with a strong perfume. Continuous flowering. Makes a very good strong and vigorous climber. Height 4.5m spread 2.4m

**'Danse de Feu' (1953)**

Spectacular, very bright, brick-red flowers, globular at first opening, loosely formed. Deep green foliage. Tolerant of shade. Continuous flowering. Height 3.5m spread 2.5m

**'Dancing Queen'**

Bright pink flowers. Repeats through the season. Good fragrance. An excellent rose for a north wall. Good glossy foliage. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Dublin Bay' (1976)**

Clusters of full, well formed, bright crimson flowers. Continuous flowering. Scented. Good glossy foliage. A good pillar rose. Healthy plant. Height 2.1m spread 1.5m

**'Eden Rose' (1988)**

An old-fashioned rose, like a white peony, frosted with raspberry. Repeats through the summer. Disease resistant. No scent. Height 2.5m spread 1.8m

**'Etoile d'Hollande' (1919)**

Large double flowers of velvety crimson. Very strong scent. Repeats through the season. Tolerates some shade. Height 3.6m spread 3m

**'Gardener's Glory'**

A recently introduced yellow climbing rose gaining a reputation for its outstanding disease resistance as well as superb fragrance. Continuous flowering and easy to train. Height 4m spread 3m

**'Ginger Syllabub'**

Heavy, pendulous, old-fashioned blooms of apricot-ginger. Very strong fragrance. Repeat flowering. Benefits from a sunny position. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Gloire de Dijon' (1853)**

Very large, fully quartered flowers of pale buff yellow. Rich scent. Perpetual flowering. Dark foliage. Height 3.6m spread 2.4m

**'Golden Showers'**

Large, semi-double, golden-yellow blooms, paling to light yellow. Flowers very freely and continuously. Sweet fragrance. Almost thornless. Extremely reliable in most climates. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Grand Award' (2010)**

Sprays of dark red double flowers with mild scent produced continuously on top of dark green foliage. Very healthy plant. Height 2.5m spread 2.5m

**'Guinee' (1939)**

Large flowers of deepest velvety maroon with golden stamens. Very scented. Repeats through the summer. Height 4.5m spread 2.4m

**'Iceberg' (1968)**

Sprays of medium size pure white flowers. Scented. Perpetual flowering. Light green foliage. Height 3m spread 3m

**'Joseph's Coat' (1964)**

A red and yellow blend of petals in a well-formed double bloom. Slight fragrance. Continual flowering. Medium green foliage. Height 2m spread 1.5m

**'Kathleen Harrop' (1919)**

Hybrid Tea shaped buds opening to loosely semi-double pale pink flowers. Very fragrant. Prone to mildew so spraying essential. Sport of Zepherine Drouhin. Almost thornless. Perpetual flowering. Tolerates shade. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Lady Hillingdon' (1917)**

Long, pointed, apricot buds open to blowsy soft apricot-yellow flowers. Perpetual flowering. Good fragrance. Best on a warm wall. Height 3.6m spread 2.4m

**'Lady Sylvia' (1933)**

Pure blush-pink, suffused with apricot blooms. Perfect Hybrid Tea shaped buds. Rich scent. Repeats through the summer. Height 3m spread 3m

**'Leaping Salmon' (1986)**

Huge salmon-pink, almost double flowers. Mid-green glossy foliage. Highly scented. Perpetual flowering. Height 2.4m spread 1.8m

**'Madame Alfred Carriere' (1879)**

Clusters of creamy white cupped flowers. Very fragrant. Perpetual flowering. Tolerates shade. Excellent rose for all situations. Excellent on a north wall. Height 3.6m spread 3m

**'Madame Caroline Testout' (1861)**

An excellent climbing sport of an earlier Hybrid Tea rose. Large pink flowers. Repeat flowering. Light, enduring fragrance. Height 4.5m spread 2.5m

**'Madame Gregoire Staechelin' (1927)**

Long buds open to large pale pink flowers, with deep veining. Delicious sweet pea scent. Repeats through the summer. Large hips in autumn. Height 4.5m spread 3.6m

**'Masquerade' (1958)**

Flowers of yellow, pink and red. Free flowering throughout summer. Vigorous growth. Light fragrance. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Mermaid' (1917)**

Large, single, butter-yellow flowers showing amber stamens. Perpetual flowering. Almost evergreen, dark glossy foliage. Fragrant. Tolerates shade. Height 7.5m spread 6m

**'Morning Jewel'**

Profusion of rose-pink blooms throughout the summer. Slight scent. Repeat flowering. Will grow in shade and difficult conditions. Healthy plant. Height 5m spread 3.5m

**'Mrs Herbert Stevens' (1922)**

Large Hybrid Tea shaped pure white flowers, tinged with green. Excellent scent. Repeats through the summer. Height 3.6m spread 2.4m

**'Nahema' (2006)**

Deeply cut pale pink blooms in profusion throughout the season. Almost thornless. Highly scented. Ideal for espalier or used as a pillar. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'New Dawn' (1930)**

Medium-sized, silvery blush-pink flowers in clusters. Perpetual flowering. Fruity fragrance. Superb healthy foliage. Tolerates shade. Height 3m spread 2.4m

**'Paul Lede' (1913)**

Large Hybrid Tea shaped blooms of soft pink with peachy shadings. Delicious scent. Perpetual. Height 4.5m spread 3.6m

**'Penny Lane' (1998)**

Masses of large honey-champagne Hybrid Tea shaped blooms with ruffled petals. Sweet scent. Repeats though the summer. Easy growing habit. Height 4m spread 2.4m

**'Schoolgirl' (1964)**

Beautiful Hybrid Tea shaped flowers of apricot-orange fading to salmon-pink. Slight sweet apricot scent. Perpetual flowering. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Sombreuil' (1850)**

Flat, quartered, rosette-shaped blooms of creamy white. Delicious scent. Perpetual flowering. Good dark foliage. Best on a warm wall. Height 3m spread 2.4m

**'Souvenir de la Malmaison' (1853)**

The climbing form of the famous old rose. Beautiful large quartered very pale pink flowers are very beautiful. Strong tea rose fragrance. A little repeating with strong growth. Height 5.5m spread 3.5m

**'Souvenir de Madame Leonie Viennot' (1858)**

Loose Tea Rose shaped flowers of pale yellow shaded with coppery pink, repeat flowering. A strong hardy climber and fragrant. Height 5.5m spread 4m.

**'Swan Lake' (1968)**

Double Hybrid Tea flowers of white with pink tints in the centre. Perpetual flowering. Fragrant. Dark green foliage. Height 2.4m spread 1.8m

**'Tradition'**

Semi-double crimson flowers produced on vigorous growth, clothed in deep-green leaves. Repeat flowering with a light scent. Suitable for shade as well as sunny sites. Height 5m spread 2.5m

**'White Cloud'**

Flowers of light crimson which are semi-double. Single summer flowering. A showy shrub with upright yet bushy growth. Good for growing in a pot and for cutting. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**‘Rosa Mundi’ (Very ancient)**

The oldest and the best known of the striped roses. It is a varied mixture of crimson and white. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Short, compact shrub. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Good for cutting. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**‘Tuscany Superb’ (1848)**

Velvety, deep crimson, semi-double flowers showing golden stamens. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Strong shrub with large foliage. Tolerates poor soil. Good for cutting and can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**‘Avon’**

**‘Cambridgeshire’**

Orange, pink and yellow blooms enhanced by a central boss of golden stamens. Slight fragrance. Continuous flowering. Can be used as a trailing shrub for pots and window boxes. Height 0.6m spread 1.2m

**‘County of Hampshire’**

Delicate pink miniature rose with characteristically tiny flowers. It repeats very well. Can be planted in ornamental containers and window boxes. Height 0.3m spread 0.5m

**‘Kent’**

Large trusses of white blooms centred yellow with golden stamens produced repeatedly throughout the season. Dark green, glossy foliage. Ideal for borders or containers. Good disease resistance. Height 0.5m spread 0.7m

**‘Matador’**

Semi-double, light red flowers produced in flushes throughout the season. Glossy, dark green foliage. Good disease resistance. Height 0.7m spread 0.5m

**‘Norfolk’**

Small clusters of double, yellow blooms. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Semi-glossy, dark green foliage. Ideal for borders or containers. Height 0.5m spread 0.6m

**‘Showmee Sunshine’**

Ground cover. Repeat flowering. This is probably the deepest yellow rose in the ground cover category, with extremely good disease resistance. Looks stunning when planted en-masse. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**‘Surrey’**

Small clusters of fragrant, double, pink blooms. Repeat flowering throughout the season. Dark green, semi-glossy foliage. Ideal for containers and borders. Height 0.9m spread 1.5m

**'Sweet Haze'**

Large clusters of sweet-scented lilac-pink flowers flowering from June until the first frosts. Glossy, mid-green foliage. Good disease resistance. Ideal for containers or the front of a border. Height 0.7m spread 0.7m

**'The Fairy' (1932)**

Clusters of small soft pink flowers until very late in the season. Graceful spreading fan-like habit. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Height 0.5m spread 0.2m

Attractive, small, white pompom-like flowers with many petals. Delicate scent. Perpetual flowering. Forms a neat mound. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Wiltshire'**

Small clusters of slightly fragrant, double, deep pink blooms produced repeatedly throughout the summer into autumn. Medium green semi-glossy foliage. Ideal for borders or containers. Good disease resistance. Height 0.4m spread 0.9m

***HYBRID MUSK*****'Buff Beauty' (1939)**

Cupped buds, open double, buff yellow full blooms. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Can be grown as a climber or pillar rose. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Cornelia' (1925)**

Massed clusters of small, double, rich salmon-pink flowers, fading to shell-pink. Repeat flowering. Very fragrant. Can be grown in a pot, or treated as a climber or pillar rose. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.5m spread 1.5m

**'Danae' (1913)**

Fragrant, loosely double apricot yellow blooms, fading to cream. Repeat flowering. Can be grown as a climber. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Felicia' (1928)**

Salmon-pink bud opening to pink flowers, deeper in the centre. Exceptionally strong fragrance. Continuous flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Francesca' (1928)**

Long apricot-yellow buds, opening to large flowers of apricot fading to cream. Delicious scent. Repeat flowering. Ample glossy foliage. Can be grown in a pot, or treated as a climber or pillar rose. Will tolerate poor soil and some shade. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Lavender Lassie' (1960)**

Large trusses of medium-sized lavender to pink flowers. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Can be treated as a pillar or climbing rose. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.2m spread 1m

**'Moonlight' (1913)**

Small clusters of very fragrant, semi-double cream blooms, flushed yellow in summer. Repeat flowering. Reddish-green foliage. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Pax' (1918)**

Sprays of large creamy white, semi-double flowers with golden stamens. Rich musky scent. Perpetual flowering. Good as a short climber. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

**'Penelope' (1924)**

Large, semi-double flowers with slightly frilled petal edges. Salmon-pink with deeper shading, fading to white. Good scent. Perpetual flowering. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

**'Prosperity' (1919)**

Large trusses of small, ivory white, semi-double flowers flushed lemon at the centre. Delicious scent. Continuous flowering. Can be treated as a climber or pillar rose. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

**'Robin Hood' (1927)**

Dense clusters of small, cherry red blooms, darkening with age. Continuous flowering. Good disease resistance. Tolerates poor soils and partial shade. Height 1.4m spread 1.6m

**'Thisbe' (1918)**

Clusters of double buff-yellow flowers. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Tolerates some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

***HYBRID PERPETUAL*****'Baron Girod de L'Ain'**

Very fragrant, double, cup-shaped crimson flowers, edged finely white. Repeat flowering. Vigorous bushy growth with prickly stems bearing dark-green foliage. Height 1.5m spread 1m

**'Baroness Rothschild' (1868)**

Large, full, slightly cupped flowers of shell pink. Good scent. Repeat flowering. Ample soft green foliage. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Captain Hayward' (1893)**

Fragrant, light crimson, high-centred, double flowers. Repeat flowering. Excellent orange hips. Tolerates poorer soils. Height 2.4m spread 1.2m

**'Comtesse Cecile de Chabrillant (1858)**

Huge, cupped, satin-pink flowers. Highly fragrant. Repeat flowering. Good, healthy foliage. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Duke of Wellington' (1874)**

Large double flowers of deep crimson that open quite loose. Repeat flowering. Pleasant fragrance. Upright growth on dark foliage. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Empereur du Maroc' (1858)**

Very double, velvety maroon-crimson flowers, full petalled, flat and quartered. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Growth is rather weak, requiring high standard of cultivation to look its best. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Ferdinand Pichard' (1921)**

Delicate pink globular flowers, striped purple. Repeat flowering. Very fragrant. Light green foliage. Tolerates poor soil. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m



**'Fisher Holmes' (1865)**

Well formed, scarlet and crimson double flowers. Well scented. Continuous flowering. Vigorous and upright growth. Can be prone to disease. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1m spread 1m

**'Gloire de Ducher' (1865)**

Gorgeous, large and blowsy flowers of deep crimson, fading to purple. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Best grown as a short climber. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Gloire Lyonnaise' (1885)**

Semi-double, creamy white blooms on a very erect shrub. Virtually thornless. Continuous flowering. Withstands wet weather better than most. Height 1.2m spread 0.6m

**'Hugh Dickson' (1905)**

Brilliant, scarlet crimson double flowers. Powerfully perfumed. Repeat flowering. Can be grown as a shrub but may need support, so best as a climber. Good for cutting. Tolerant of poor soil. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Madame Scipion Cochet' (1873)**

Attractively wrinkled, cup-shaped flowers, deep purplish-pink paling to softer shades at the edges. Repeat flowering. Very fragrant. Dark green foliage on a bushy shrub. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Mrs John Laing' (1887)**

Large, finely shaped, silvery pink flowers. Perpetual flowering. Very scented. Can be grown in a pot. An excellent bushy shrub, one of the best Hybrid Perpetuals. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Prince Camille de Rohan'**

One of the darkest of all roses with very double, velvety crimson-maroon flowers. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Susceptible to disease. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Reine des Violettes' (1860)**

Cupped flowers of rich velvety violet, opening flat and quartered. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Almost thornless. Tolerant of poor soil. Height 1.5m spread 0.9m

**'Souvenir du Docteur Jamain' (1865)**

Deep maroon-crimson flowers, semi-double opening to a cup shape. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Can be grown as a climber. Suitable for a north aspect. Dark green foliage and relatively thornless. Tolerates poor soil. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

**'Vicks Caprice' (1891)**

Large, double, cupped flowers of pale pink and lilac, with white flecks and deeper pink stripes. Continuous flowering. Good fragrance. Attractive light-green foliage on a relatively thornless bush. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Yolande d'Aragon' (1843)**

Clusters of sumptuous, quartered, rich-pink flowers. Highly fragrant. Repeat flowering. Upright bushy growth. Size 1.2m spread 1m

Beautifully formed double, pale pink to pale apricot flowers from late spring through to autumn. Healthy and reliable. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Height 1.2m spread 0.8m

**'Nevada' (1927)**

Semi-double creamy-white blooms, opening white, showing rich golden stamens. Repeat flowering. Good fragrance. Can be grown as a climber or a pillar rose. Tolerates poor soil. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Night Owl'**

Eye catching clusters of large, semi-double blooms in repeating waves from June to November. A stunning, deep, velvety purple rose with cream centres and contrasting yellow stamens. Unusual fruity scent. Matt green foliage. Good disease resistance. Height 1.2m spread 0.6m

**'Octavia Hill'**

Old-fashioned, double quartered, medium-sized pink flowers. Delightful fragrance. Repeat flowering. Dark green foliage. Ideal for cutting. Height 1.1m spread 0.7m

**'Pearl Drift' (1980)**

Large semi-double, pearly white flowers showing golden stamens. Good fragrance. Perpetual flowering. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Can be grown in a pot. Height 0.9m spread 1.2m

**'Red Finesse' (2000)**

Huge clusters of glowing red blooms, continuously flowering throughout the summer and into autumn. Healthy, dark green, glossy foliage. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Rosy Cushion' (1979)**

An excellent, well-rounded shrub with almost single, soft pink flowers with paler centres. Repeat flowering. Dense and bushy growth. Hardy and healthy. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Roundelay' (1953)**

Clusters of large, high centred double blooms of deep velvety red. Good perfume. Healthy dark green foliage. Repeat flowering. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Sally Holmes' (1976)**

Huge trusses of soft pale pink to white flowers. Good scent. Perpetual flowering. Tolerates some shade. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m



**'Scharlachglut' (1952)**

Rich, glowing scarlet flowers with crimson overtones with pronounced golden stamens in the centre. Summer flowering. Strong vigorous growth with strong purple-brown stems. Large hips in autumn. Can be trained against a pillar or wall. Height 3m spread 2m

**'Smiles'**

Yellow blooms tinged with cerise pink. The pink tints intensify as the weather gets sunnier, providing an ever-changing display from June through to October. Light fragrance. Upright habit. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Susan' (1999)**

Creamy white quartered blooms that open flat. Good fragrance. Perpetual flowering. Hardy and healthy. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Sweet Pretty'**

Pretty, single, creamy-pink flowers with red stamens. Very long flowering season. Sweet fragrance. Height 0.9m spread 0.5m

**'Yvonne Rabier' (1910)**

Clusters of white double flowers with hints of lemon. Little fragrance. Continuous flowering. Light green foliage and almost thornless. Can be grown as ground cover. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**MOSS****'Captain John Ingram' (1854)**

Full blooms varying from dark crimson to purple with a button eye. Summer flowering. Good scent. Sticky reddish moss has a pine fragrance. Dark foliage. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Common Moss' (Pre-1700)**

Flowers pure rose pink, large and cup shaped. Very pretty buds that are covered in moss. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering but lasts a long period. Good for cutting. Tolerates poor soil. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Eugenie Guinoiseau'**

Substantial and cupped cherry-red double flowers. Dark green moss. Occasional repeat flowering. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Gloire de Mousseux' (1852)**

Huge blooms of clear pink, opening from buds with light green moss. Very fragrant. Occasionally repeats. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerant of poor soil. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Henri Martin'**

Neatly rounded, semi-double flowers of pure crimson, later becoming purple-crimson. Summer flowering. The long buds are sparsely covered with light green moss. Heavily scented. Red hips later in the season. Vigorous growth which may need supporting. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Laneii' (1854)**

A beautiful double flower of deep pink to crimson. Fantastic mossed buds before the flower opens. Strongly scented. Single summer flowering. Good disease resistance. Height 1.2m spread 1m

**'Madame Louis Leveque' (1898)**

Cup shaped flowers of the purest pink. Soft silky textured petals. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Nuits de Young'**

Flat, double, velvety, deep maroon-purple flowers with yellow stamens. It will only flower once. Red-brown moss on stems and buds. Very fragrant. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Shailer's White' (1788)**

Full, flat and quartered white blooms with the occasional hint of pink. Very fragrant. One very long flowering period. Graceful mossy buds, tinged pink. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'William Lobb' (1855)**

A blend of purple, grey and magenta flowers, fading to lilac. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Heavily mossy buds and ample large green foliage. Suitable to grow as a climber or pillar rose. Tolerates poor soil. Height 2.5m spread 1.5m

***PATIO/MINATURE*****'Brilliant Sweet Dream'**

Pretty, double, blazing orange flowers produced throughout the season. Medium green foliage. Hardy. Good disease resistance. Ideal for containers. Height 0.6m spread 0.5m

**'Cutie'**

Clusters of small, lightly fragrant, fully double, ivory-white flowers with pale yellow centres produced from June to mid-October. Glossy mid-green foliage. Ideal for containers. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Flower Power'**

Salmon pink blooms produced in clusters throughout the season. Extremely free flowering. Spicy fragrance. Low, compact, disease resistant growth. Height 0.6m spread 0.5m

**'Flower Power Gold'**

Clusters of rich golden yellow blooms produced repeatedly throughout the summer into the autumn. Blooms are slow to open and long lasting. Small, dark green glossy foliage. Excellent disease resistance. Height 0.6m spread 0.5m

**'Honeybun'**

Rosette-shaped, fully double, apricot to peach flowers produced throughout the season. Lightly fragrant. Glossy, dark green foliage. Disease resistant. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Little Cherub'**

Deep red, rosette-shaped flowers produced in large clusters. Flowers from late spring until the first frosts. Small, glossy, dark green foliage. Compact, bushy growth. Ideal for containers. Height 0.4m spread 0.3m

**'Nina'**

Clusters of single red flowers with a yellow centre. Glossy, dark green foliage. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Phyllis'**

Clusters of pink buds open to lightly fragrant, double, pink-flushed, white flowers. Repeat flowering. Glossy, dark green foliage. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Pretty Polly'**

Clusters of well-shaped buds open into a stunning display of slightly scented pink blooms. Repeat flowering. Medium green foliage. Good disease resistance. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Starry Eyed'**

Large sprays of single deep reddish-pink flowers with a wide white to pale yellow eye. Flowers from early summer until autumn. Glossy, dark green foliage. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**'Sweet Memories'**

Large clusters of well formed, soft lemon-cream blooms produced throughout the summer until the first frost. Slightly scented. Healthy, dark green, glossy foliage. Good disease resistance. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Top Marks'**

Small flowers of sparkling, vibrant vermillion. Slight scent. Repeat flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Height 0.5m spread 0.4m

**'Warm Welcome'**

Small bright orange flowers against dark foliage. Good fragrance. Repeat flowering. Patio climber. Can be grown in a pot. Height 2m spread 1m

**'Wildfire'**

Small Hybrid Tea shaped flowers of a striking orange. Continuous flowering. Medium fragrance. Good for a container. Height 0.6m spread 0.4m

***RAMBLER*****'Adelaide d'Orleans' (1826)**

Clusters of small, shapely, semi-double, soft pink to creamy white flowers. Single summer flowering. Dark green foliage. Primrose fragrance. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Alberic Barbier' (1900)**

Fully double, creamy white flowers flushed yellow in bud, produced in clusters. Glossy, bright green foliage. Mainly summer flowering but will often repeat later in the season. Tolerates partial shade. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Albertine' (1921)**

Reddish salmon buds, opening to coppery-pink, double and muddled flowers. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Alexandre Girault' (1900)**

Double flowers with muddled petals of an attractive but unusual mixture of deep rose pink and copper. Single summer flowering. Strong fruity scent. Very pliable stems with polished foliage. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**‘American Pillar’ (1909)**

Single flowers of reddish pink, with an off-white centre, usually in large trusses. Slight fragrance. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**‘Banksia Lutea’**

Graceful sprays of small, double, deep yellow flowers produced in April and May. Lightly scented. Thornless, mid-green foliage. Prefers a sheltered position. Height 6m spread 2.5m

**‘Belvedere’ (Syn. Princess Marie) (1929)**

Large trusses of soft pink flowers full of short petals, distinctly cupped. Good fragrance. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**‘Betty Sheriff’ (1949)**

Clusters of small, star-like single white blooms flushed pale pink. Highly scented. Single summer flowering. Dark glossy leaves and red shoots. Height 6m spread 2.5m

**‘Bleu Magenta’ (C. 1900)**

Clusters of small, double flowers of violet-crimson, fading to violet, showing yellow stamens. Single summer flowering. Sweetly scented. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 3.6m spread 3m

**‘Bloomfield Courage’ (1925)**

Masses of small, deep red, single flowers each with prominent golden stamens. Dark green foliage. Pendulous weeping variety. Single summer flowering. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**‘Blush Rambler’ (1903)**

Clusters of cupped, semi-double flowers in at least three shades of pink. Deliciously fragrant. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Height 3.5m spread 3m

**‘Bobbie James’ (1960)**

Large clusters of creamy white semi-double blooms. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown into a tree. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 9m spread 6m

**‘Crimson Showers’ (1951)**

Trusses of bright crimson, pompon like flowers. Slightly scented. Long but single summer flowering. Mid green, shiny foliage. Tolerates poor soil. Height 4.5m spread 2.5m

**‘Debutante’ (1920)**

Dainty sprays of small, clear rose-pink fully double flowers. Slight scent. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 3.5m spread 3m

**‘Dortmund’ (1955)**

Clusters of large, single, crimson flowers with a white eye. Repeat flowering. Slight fragrance. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 2.5m spread 1.8m

**‘Ethel’ (1912)**

Large cascading clusters of double mauve pink flowers. Very fragrant. Single summer flowering. Vigorous growth. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 6m spread 4.5m

**'Felicite et Perpetue' (1827)**

Clusters of pink-tinted buds, opening to fully double creamy-white flowers. Well scented. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Fimbriata' (1891)**

Clusters of carnation-like flowers of soft pink. Scented. Repeat flowering. Rich, light green foliage. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Gardenia' (1899)**

Clusters of fully double, quartered flowers of soft creamy-yellow to white. Pleasing fragrance. Single summer flowering. Very vigorous growth with dark green foliage. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 6m spread 4.5m

**'Ghislane de Feligonde' (1916)**

Clusters of fully double orange to yellow flowers. Good fragrance. Repeat flowering. Almost thornless and very healthy. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 2.5m spread 2.5m

**'Kiftsgate' (1954)**

Huge sprays of fragrant white flowers produced in late summer, followed by masses of tiny orange-red hips. Plentiful light green foliage. Extremely vigorous growth. Tolerates considerable shade. Height 10m spread 8m

**'Kew Rambler' (1912)**

Single flowers of soft mid-pink with deeper edging. Good, greyish-green foliage. Thorny. Single summer flowering. Lightly scented. Will tolerate some shade. Height 5.4m spread 6m

**'Laura Devoust' (1834)**

Huge clusters of dainty rosette double blooms of bright pink, paling to soft pink then white. Single summer flowering. Good fragrance. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Good vigorous and healthy growth. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Leverkusen' (1954)**

Sprays of large, fully double, rosette-shaped pale yellow flowers produced throughout the summer and early autumn. Very fragrant. Will tolerate some shade. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Narrow Waters' (1883)**

Huge clusters of semi-double lilac pink flowers that fade to white. Good scent. Repeat flowering. Dark foliage. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 2.5m spread 1.8m

**'Paul's Himalayan Musk' (1916)**

Small, double, lavender-pink flowers produced in drooping clusters. Single summer flowering. Slightly fragrant. Dark green foliage with hints of copper when young. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Can be grown into a tree. Height 6m spread 3.5m

**'Paul Transon' (1901)**

Double flowers of rich salmon pink with coppery overtones. Shiny, copper tinted, dark green foliage. Lightly scented. Repeat flowering. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Perennial Blue'**

Small double lavender purple flowers aging to lilac grey. Light fragrance. Repeat flowering. Healthy and vigorous growth. Height 4.5m spread 3.6m

**'Phyllis Bide' (1923)**

Small, slightly ragged flowers of cream, pink and yellow. Slightly scented. Repeat flowering. Vigorous and thorn free growth. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Purity' (1917)**

Clusters of large, semi-double white or near white blooms produced in a single summer flowering. Mild fragrance. Lush, dark green foliage. Height 3.5m spread 2.4m

**'Rambling Rector'**

Large clusters of creamy white semi-double flowers, showing yellow stamens. Very scented. Single summer flowering. Small hips in autumn. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Can be grown into a tree. Height 6m spread 4.5m

**'Rambling Rosie' (2006)**

Bright red, semi-double blooms with an attractive white eye produced in clusters. Flowers freely all summer. Strong, glossy foliage. Slight scent. Will tolerate a small amount of shade. Height 3m spread 2.4m

**'Sander's White' (1912)**

Large clusters of pure white semi-double rosette shaped flowers. Delicious fresh scent. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 3.5m spread 2.5m

**'Seagull' (1907)**

Large clusters of single, pure white flowers with pronounced golden stamens. Single summer flowering. Lightly scented. Healthy grey-green foliage. Ideal for scrambling through old trees and covering unsightly buildings. Good disease resistance. Height 7m spread 4.5m

**'Spectabilis' (1850)**

Clusters of small, double, peach, raspberry and cream blooms. Can repeat in autumn. Good dark green foliage. Lightly scented. Will tolerate some shade. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'The Albrighton Rambler'**

Large sprays of small, cup-shaped soft-pink flowers with a central button eye. Light musk fragrance. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Height 3.5m spread 2m

**'The Garland' (1835)**

Small creamy white flowers with narrow quilled petals, sometimes tinged pink. Rich orange scent. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Good for climbing through trees. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'The Lady of the Lake' (2014)**

Long slender stems carry sprays of slightly ruffled, semi-double flowers of soft pink with yellow stamens. Strong, sweet scent. Repeat flowering. Height 3m spread 2.5m

**'Trier' (1904)**

Semi-double flowers of straw-yellow to whitish-pink produced in clusters. Light musk scent. Repeat flowering. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Veilchenblau' (1909)**

Clusters of small magenta to lilac flowers, streaked white. Single summer flowering. Pleasant fragrance. Almost thornless. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 4.5m spread 3.5m

**'Violette' (1921)**

Small, cupped, very double, violet-purple flowers borne on large trusses. Light, fruit-like fragrance. Almost thornless. Vigorous. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Wedding Day' (1950)**

Large trusses of single white flowers with yellow stamens. Single summer flowering. Exceptional fragrance. Fairly thornless. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Good for growing into trees. Height 9m spread 4.5m

***RUGOSA***

**'Agnes' (1922)**

Large, double flowers of rich yellow and amber, fading to white. Delicious scent. Repeats intermittently throughout the season after the first flush in June. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

**'Blanc Double de Coubert' (1892)**

Magnificent shrub with large, semi-double, pure white flowers. Perpetual flowering. Very scented. Fruit sometimes quite large, only sets intermittently. Excellent for hedging. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Frau Dagmar Hastrup' (1914)**

Clear silver-pink single flowers with pronounced stamens. Good fragrance. Continuous flowering. Enormous red hips in autumn. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 0.9m spread 1.2m

**'Hansa' (1905)**

Large, cupped, double, reddish-violet blooms. Very fragrant. Produces hips. Will tolerate partial shade. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Jens Munk' (1974)**

Fragrant, mauve-pink, fully double flowers with conspicuous yellow stamens. Blooms in flushes throughout the season. Highly scented. Small, medium green foliage. Height 2m spread 1.5m

**'Mrs Anthony Waterer' (1898)**

Semi-double, shapely deep crimson blooms. Continuous flowering. Very fragrant. A vigorous, broad, thorny bush with dark green foliage. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.2m spread 1.5m

**'Rosa Rugosa Alba' (c. 1870)**

Silky textured pure-white single flowers, showing golden stamens, followed by orange-red hips. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Deeply veined, coarse textured, slightly glossy foliage. Excellent hedging or woodland planting. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.2m spread 1.5m

**'Roseaie de l'Hay' (1901)**

Splendid, large semi-double crimson-purple flowers, opening loosely flat. Strongly scented. Continuous flowering. Only occasionally sets fruit, but very good autumn foliage. Good for hedging. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

**'Sarah Van Fleet' (1926)**

Large, slightly cupped, semi-double rose-pink flowers with cream stamens. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Good for hedging and woodland planting. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Can be prone to rust. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Scabrosa'**

Large, single, rich velvety deep pinkish-mauve flowers with creamy stamens. Continuous flowering. Immense orange-red hips. Luxuriant foliage. Will tolerate some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

**'Schneezwerg' (1912)**

Pure white, semi-double flowers with yellow stamens in summer and autumn, often followed by large red hips. Perpetual flowering. Will tolerate some shade. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Yellow Dagmar Hastrup' (1987)**

Sizeable semi-double primrose yellow flowers. Huge orange hips. Continuous flowering. Very fragrant. Dark green foliage. Spreading habit good for ground cover. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerant of poor soil and shade. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

## **SPECIES**

**Rosa macrantha 'Raubritter' (1967)**

A charming trailing rose, clusters of cupped, silvery pink, semi-double flowers. Long flowering period in late summer. Good fragrance. Excellent as ground cover. Tolerant of poor soil and shade. Can suffer from mildew. Height 0.9m spread 1.8m

**Rosa moyesii 'Geranium' (1938)**

Beautiful, single orange-red flowers, showing creamy anthers. Enormous deep red flagon-shaped hips. Single summer flowering. Can be grown as a climber or pillar rose. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Height 2.5m spread 1.5m

**Rosa pimpinellifolia**

Masses of single, creamy-white flowers followed by purple-black hips during spring. Minimal scent. Attractive fern-like foliage. Very disease resistant. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**Rosa pimpinellifolia 'Double Yellow'**

Abundant spherical, double, golden-yellow blooms. Early flowering. Slightly fragrant. Attractive fern-like foliage. Very hardy. Height 1.5m spread 1m

**Rosa pimpinellifolia 'Dunwich Rose' (1950)**

Early flowering, soft lemon single blooms. Minimal scent. Attractive fern-like foliage. Very thorny. Will tolerate some shade. Good disease resistance. Height 0.6m spread 1.2m

**'Rosa rubrifolia' (glauca) (1830)**

Clusters of small mauve-pink flowers, producing oval, red hips in autumn. Slight fragrance. Single summer flowering. Can be planted in a northerly aspect. Good autumn colour. Can be planted as hedging or in woodland. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m



**Rosa Sericea 'Pteracantha' (1890)**

Creamy-white flowers in summer, followed by small, orange-red hips. Neat fern-like foliage. Large, flat, crimson prickles on the young growth. Height 2.5m spread 2.5m

**'Stanwell Perpetual' (1838)**

Double, quartered, soft blush-pink flowers. Very fragrant. Can be grown in a pot. Good for hedging or woodland planting. Repeat flowering. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Height 1.5m spread 1.5m
