## **Planting**

Good preparation is the key to success here. The area in which roses are to be planted should be free from weeds and deeply dug with the addition of plenty of well-rotted manure and bonemeal. Soil that has previously grown roses should be removed to a depth of 18 inches and replaced with fresh soil from somewhere else. This should be completed in advance of planting to allow the soil to settle. Container roses can be planted at any time but avoid planting if it's extremely wet and frosty. Dig a hole large enough to accommodate the spread of the roots, and break up the soil at the bottom of the hole to allow the roots to go deeper into the soil. Mix a small spadeful of well-rotted manure in the bottom of the hole to provide nutrients for the soil. Apply mycorrhizal fungi to the bottom and the sides of the hole as this will aid root development.

Before removing the rose from its pot, water it generously. Remember to remove the pot and try not to disturb the root ball too much. Place a few handfuls of planting mixture over the roots. Replace the rest of the soil and firm down well, if dry conditions prevail then water well. No pruning is required in the first year after planting.

## **Maintenance**

Roses, like other plants, have basic requirements for survival, namely adequate light, heat, water and nutrition. Insufficient of any of these will put the plants under stress and this is when disease and poor growth result. Try to plant in open sunny positions; some roses will tolerate partial shade but most do better when not in shade. It is very important the roses get sufficiently watered in the first few years and a good drenching during very hot spells is often required. Mulching with well-rotted manure or garden compost in early spring and the application of fertilizer in March and June should satisfy the plants nutritional requirements. Should pests such as aphids or leaf rolling sawfly be active then spraying with an insecticide might be necessary. Diseases such as mildew, blackspot and rust are best prevented by good husbandry. Spraying with a fungicide is also recommended and it is best to alternate two different sprays at fortnightly intervals.

## **Pruning**

Always prune old fashioned roses in late February or early March after planting. Thereafter only prune after flowering to tidy the bush by removing dead or unhealthy wood, or to reduce size. Never prune in hard weather.

Always take out any dead, diseased or crossing wood first and then follow the pruning guide below.

Remove spent blooms throughout the season to encourage new growth.

## **Damasks**

Prune summer flowering varieties once established by a removal of one or two very old stems after flowering. Recurrent varieties have their stems shortened by one third in Feb/March.

## **Chinensis**

Tend to make small twiggy shrubs if left unpruned. Prune each spring to encourage basal growth.

### **Bourbons, Hybrid Musks and Hybrid Perpetuals**

Prune by one third early in the spring to encourage new shoots and to prevent leggy plants.

### **Rugosa**

Prune only to keep in the desired shape, either hedge or bush.

### **Hybrid Teas**

Should be pruned hard the first year by cutting back to within 3 or 4 inches from the ground to an outward eye. Shorten the retained shoots made in the previous year by half their length, choosing a plump outward eye.

### **Floribunda Roses**

In the first year reduce the shoots to about 5 inches from the ground, again choosing outward eyes. In future years use common sense in preserving an open plant approach. New growth from the base made the previous year should only be pruned to the first good eye below a flowering truss. Two year old wood can be reduced by half and older wood can be eliminated altogether.

### **Patio Miniature Roses**

These roses often produce a mass of twiggy growth. After this unproductive wood has been removed, the main stems should be reduced by about one-third to a healthy bud or lateral. Remove entirely any over-vigorous shoots that spoil the shape of the bush.

### **Climbers and Ramblers**

For the first two years train strong shoots to the wall. Later when plants are well established, lateral growth can be cut back. Ramblers and climbers growing on trees are best left untouched, whereas for ramblers on poles or walls it is necessary to remove flowering shoots after flowering and tie in the new shoots.

## **HISTORICAL ROSES**

### **BOURBON**

#### **'Boule de Neige' (1867)**

Double, globular, pure white flowers. Buds tinged purple-red. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Upright growth with good dark green foliage. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

#### **'La Reine Victoria' (1872)**

Globular, double blooms of paper-thin, shell-like petals of delicate lilac-pink. Very fragrant. Upright, arching growth. Suitable for a container. Perpetual flowering. Height 1.2m spread 1m

#### **'Louise Odier' (1851)**

A profusion of warm, glowing pink globular flowers. Very strong fragrance. Good for cutting. Perpetual flowering. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

#### **'Madame Isaac Pereire' (1881)**

Fully double purple-crimson flowers with paler reverse. Very scented blooms. Repeat flowering. Equally good as a short climber. Tolerates light shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.2m

#### **'Madame Pierre Oger' (1878)**

Medium sized, chalice shaped flowers of pale silvery-pink. Repeat flowering. Richly scented. Slender upright growth. Height 1.5m spread 0.9m

### **CHINENSIS**

#### **'Mutabilis' (1880)**

Clusters of single flowers, flame to copper-yellow buds, fading to pink then copper crimson. Bronze foliage. Perpetual flowering. Slight fragrance. Excellent disease resistance. Tolerates shade. Good in a container. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

#### **'Sophie's Perpetual' (1928)**

Large double blooms of cerise pink. Repeat flowering and fragrant. Dark green foliage and almost thornless. Can be grown as a climber if left unpruned. Height 2.4m spread 1.2m

#### **'Viridiflora' – The Green Rose (1883)**

A novelty or collector's specimen. The 'flowers' are actually layers of green sepals, tinted brown and pink. Continuous flowering. Tolerant of some shade. A useful addition to floral arrangements. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

### **DAMASK**

#### **'Comte de Chambord' (1860)**

Bright, rich pink, quartered flowers packed with petals with lilac shading. Perpetual flowering. Very scented. Good small sturdy shrub. Light green foliage. Good for cutting. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

#### **'Jacques Cartier' (1868)**

Fully quartered flowers of clear pink, with a button eye. Very scented. Repeat flowering. Will tolerate some shade. Good for cutting or growing in a container. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Rose de Rescht' (Unknown date)**

Small, neat, full flowers of deep ruby red produced in small upright clusters amid lots of foliage. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Tolerates poor soil. Good in a container. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

***HYBRID MUSK***

**'Ballerina' (1937)**

Large clusters of small, clear pink single flowers with a white eye. Slight fragrance. Perpetual flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.3m spread 0.9m

**'Buff Beauty' (1939)**

Cupped buds, open double, buff yellow full blooms. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Can be grown in a pot. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Can be grown as a climber or pillar rose. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Felicia' (1928)**

Salmon-pink bud opening to pink flowers, deeper in the centre. Exceptionally strong fragrance. Continuous flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Penelope' (1924)**

Semi-double creamy pink blooms fading to white. Repeat flowering. Good scent. Very healthy. Forms hips in the autumn. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Prosperity' (1919)**

Large trusses of small, ivory white, semi-double flowers flushed lemon at the centre. Delicious scent. Continuous flowering. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

***HYBRID PERPETUAL***

**'Paul Neyron' (1869)**

Large, cupped flowers of deep rose pink flushed with lilac. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Vigorous, upright habit. Height 1.5m spread 1m

**'Reine des Violettes' (1860)**

Cupped flowers of rich velvety violet, opening flat and quartered. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Almost thornless. Tolerant of poor soil. Height 1.5m spread 0.9m

**'Souvenir du Docteur Jamain' (1865)**

Deep maroon-crimson semi-double flowers. Very fragrant. Repeat flowering. Can be grown as a climber. Suitable for a north aspect. Dark green foliage and relatively thornless. Tolerates poor soil. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

## **CLIMBER**

### **'Alaska'**

Double flowers of creamy white with suffused pink edges. Repeat flowering. Healthy mid-green foliage. Compact and easily manageable. Height 2.4m spread 1.5m

### **'Alister Stella Gray' (1894)**

Clusters of tightly scrolled yolk-yellow buds opening to rosette-shaped creamy flowers. Scented. Perpetual flowering. Height 4.5m spread 3m

### **'Blue Moon'**

Large, classic Hybrid Tea shaped blooms of lilac-blue. Strongly scented. Repeat flowering. Almost thornless. Height 4m spread 3m

### **'Camelot'**

This unusual, large flowering climber has striking mid-pink flowers with novel dark pink veining running through each of its petals. Good fragrance. Repeat flowering. Height 2.5m spread 3m

### **'Compassion' (1973)**

Hybrid Tea shaped flowers, salmon-pink, tinted with apricot orange. Excellent fragrance. Good dark foliage. Repeats through the summer. Height 3m spread 1.8m

### **'Crimson Cascade' (1991)**

Shapely blooms of deep velvet red with a strong perfume. Repeat flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Height 3m spread 2m

### **'Danse de Feu' (1953)**

Spectacular, very bright, brick-red flowers, globular at first opening, loosely formed. Deep green foliage. Tolerant of shade. Continuous flowering. Height 3.5m spread 2.5m

### **'Deep Love' (2022)**

Ball-shaped blooms of warm wine red with creamy white hues. Strongly scented. Resistant to powdery mildew and blackspot. Can be trained on arches, trellises, or pergolas. Height 3m spread 1.8m

### **'Divina'**

Large, old-fashioned soft pink flowers. Highly fragrant. Disease resistant. Repeat flowering. Height 3m spread 2.5m

### **'Dublin Bay' (1976)**

Clusters of full, well formed, bright crimson flowers. Continuous flowering. Scented. Good glossy foliage. A good pillar rose. Healthy plant. Height 2.1m spread 1.5m

### **'Eden Rose' (1988)**

An old-fashioned rose, like a white peony, frosted with raspberry. Repeats through the summer. Disease resistant. Lightly scented. Height 2.5m spread 1.8m

### **'Ena Harkness' (1954)**

Formal Crimson flowers. Very strong scent. Repeats through the season. Tolerates shade and poor soil. A good variety for a North wall. Height 3.6m spread 3m

### **'Etoile d'Hollande' (1919)**

Large double flowers of velvety crimson. Very strong scent. Repeats through the season. Tolerates some shade. Height 3.6m spread 3m

**'Ginger Syllabub'**

Heavy, pendulous, old-fashioned blooms of apricot-ginger. Very strong fragrance. Repeat flowering. Benefits from a sunny position. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'High Hopes' (1992)**

Medium sized, hybrid-tea flowers of light pink, fading to pale peach. Light fragrance. Repeat flowering. Stiff, upright growth. Height 4m spread 1.8m

**'Ivory Castle'**

Double, creamy white blooms fading to ivory. Repeat flowering. Sweetly scented. Disease resistant. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Looking Up'**

A Persica rose producing masses of peach to pink single flowers with a darker eye. A compact patio climber. Lightly scented. Height 1.8m spread 1.8m

**'Lucy in the Sky'**

Large, old fashioned, rosette shaped blooms of light pink. Repeat flowering. Strongly scented. Good disease resistance. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Madame Alfred Carriere' (1879)**

Clusters of creamy white cupped flowers. Very fragrant. Perpetual flowering. Excellent on a north wall. Height 3.6m spread 3m

**'Masquerade' (1958)**

A vigorous climbing version of the floribunda rose. Semi-double yellow blooms that fade to deep pink with age. Light fragrance. Repeat flowering. Height 5.5m spread 3m

**'Meg'**

Large, almost single pink-apricot flowers with red-gold stamens. Repeat flowering. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Morning Jewel' (1968)**

Semi-double flowers of rich pink borne singly and in clusters. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Disease resistant and shade tolerant. Height 3m spread 3m

**'Oh Wow!'**

Deep purple, single petalled blooms with white stripes and golden centres. Repeat flowering. Fragrant. Glossy foliage with lightly thorned stems. Height 3m spread 1.8m

**'Ozeana'**

Large, cupped soft lilac blooms. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Attractive mid-green foliage. Can be grown as a large shrub rose. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Peach Melba'**

Rose of the Year 2023. Rich orange-apricot blooms flushed with pink. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Good disease resistance. A compact patio climber. Height 2.0m spread 1.5m

**'Perfume Dreams'**

Clusters of white flowers with cream undertones. Repeat flowering. Strongly scented. Good disease resistance. Perfect for smaller walls or patio planting. Height 2m spread 1.5m

**'Peter's Persica' (2023)**

A unique climbing Persica rose. Yellow semi-double blooms with a red eye. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Disease resistant. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Pippin'**

Full blooms of warm pink flowers. Repeat flowering. Sweet fragrance. Dark green glossy foliage. Height 2.4m spread 1.2m

**'Skyline' (2020)**

Sweetly scented, bright orange flowers. Repeat flowering. A tough easy grower with good disease resistance. Height 3m spread 2m

**'Solstice Glow'**

Heavily petalled, cup-shaped blooms of light peach. Repeat flowering. Strong fruity fragrance. Healthy glossy foliage. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Summer Wine' (1984)**

Large, single flowers of coral pink with prominent red stamens. Strongly scented. Repeat flowering. Can be grown on a north facing wall. Height 3.5m spread 1.8m

**'Sunrise' (1994)**

Vibrant copper orange flowers with red, yellow and pink blends. Repeat flowering. Good fragrance. Healthy bronze-green foliage. Height 2m spread 1.8m

**'Sweet Syrie'**

Large, soft pink flowers that age to peach. Repeat flowering. Strong, sweet fragrance. Healthy, glossy foliage. Height 2.5m spread 1.5m

**'Tangerine Tango' (2013)**

Semi-double flowers of bright orange with an attractive yellow centre borne in large sprays. Lightly scented. Repeat flowering. Very healthy. Height 2.5m spread 1m

**'The Lakeland Rose'**

Small, semi-double pale pink flowers with clear yellow stamens. Repeat flowering. Strong, sweet scent. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'The Simple Life'**

Pale pink single flowers with orange stamens. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Good for pollinators. Height 2.5m spread 2m

**'Westerland' (1962)**

A small patio climber. Clusters of ruffled apricot-orange flowers with a strong and spicy fragrance. Repeat flowering. Healthy, glossy-green foliage. Height 1.5m spread 0.9m

## ***ENGLISH CLIMBER***

**'Bathsheba' (2016)**

Large, fully quartered rosette blooms of light apricot and yellow. Repeat flowering. Strong myrrh fragrance. Height 3m spread 2m

**'Claire Austin' (2007)**

Large, cupped, creamy white blooms with a strong fragrance of myrrh, meadowsweet and vanilla. Vigorous and particularly healthy with elegant arching growth. Height 3.6m spread 2m

**'Gertrude Jekyll' (1986)**

Beautiful, rich pink rosettes with a strong Old Rose fragrance. Repeat flowering. Very healthy and reliable. Height 3m spread 2m

**'The Generous Gardener' (2002)**

Large, delicate, cup-shaped flowers of palest pink. Strong and delicious fragrance. Extremely healthy. Height 3m spread 2m

## ***ENGLISH ROSES***

**'Bring me Sunshine' (2022)**

Deeply cupped rosette blooms of sunset orange, fading to apricot with age. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Height 1.2m spread 1m

**'Emma Bridgewater'**

Ruffled pink flowers with a yellow eye, softening to mauve and lilac. Repeat flowering. Medium Tea fragrance. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Gentle Hermione' (2005)**

Beautiful pure pink blooms particularly resistant to rain. Classic old rose scent. Repeat flowering. Attractive healthy growth. Height 1.2m spread 1m

**'Gertrude Jekyll' (1986)**

Scrolled buds, opening to large rosettes of rich pink. Wonderful strong scent. Perpetual flowering. Very healthy and reliable shrub. Height 1.2m spread 1m

**'Golden Celebration' (1992)**

Very large, deeply cupped blooms of deep golden yellow. Exceptionally fragrant. Repeat flowering. Excellent shapely growth with some arching stems. Dark glossy foliage. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**'Lichfield Angel' (2006)**

Large, creamy white, dome-shaped rosettes. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Ideal for poor soil. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Nye Bevan' (2021)**

Open cupped blooms of soft yellow, paling to cream with age. Repeat flowering. Light fragrance. A healthy, upright shrub. Height 1.1m spread 0.7m

**'Port Sunlight' (2007)**

Flat, quartered, rosette shaped blooms of rich apricot. There is a strong rich tea fragrance. An excellent and reliable variety. Repeat flowering. Height 1.4m spread 1.4m

**'Roald Dahl' (2016)**

Beautiful orange-red buds open to cupped peach rosettes with a lovely tea fragrance. Repeat flowering. Few thorns. Height 1.2m spread 1m

**'Scepter'd Isle' (1996)**

Light-pink, cupped flowers, becoming paler on the outer petals. Repeat flowering. Strong myrrh fragrance. Height 1.2 spread 1.2

**'Tranquillity' (2012)**

An attractive, very floriferous variety, bearing pure white, beautifully rounded, rosette blooms. Almost thornless with very healthy, vigorous growth. Light apple fragrance. Height 1.2m spread 1.2m

**FLORIBUNDA****'Absolutely Fabulous'**

Masses of ruffled butter-yellow blooms. Strong, unusual myrrh scent. Continuous flowering. Short, bushy growth. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**'Adorable Parfuma'**

Cupped, globular blooms of violet-pink. Repeat flowering. Intense fruity fragrance. Glossy, dark green foliage. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'A Fond Farewell'**

Coral-pink, lightly ruffled double blooms. Repeat flowering. Fragrant. Disease resistant. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'Angel Eyes'**

A persica type rose with semi-double lilac/pink blooms with a magenta eye. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Anniversary Wishes'**

Masses of butter yellow blooms produced in clusters. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. A healthy bushy shrub. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Arizona Sun' (2023)**

Abundant orange/amber blooms borne on an upright bush. Repeat flowering. Strong sweet fragrance. Healthy glossy foliage. Height 0.9m spread 0.5m

**'Arthur Bell' (1965)**

Semi-double flowers of deep rich yellow, fading to lemon with age. Strong fragrance. Repeat flowering. Mid to dark green glossy foliage. Height 0.5m spread 0.3m

**'Belle de Jour'**

Rose of the year 2021. Double blooms of peach and lemon. Repeat flowering. Strong vanilla fragrance. Height 1m spread 1m

**'Bernstein' (Bee's Paradise)**

A compact Persica rose bearing semi-double, soft apricot flowers with a darker eye. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Disease resistant. Good for pollinators. Height 0.6m spread 0.5m

**'Birthday Girl'**

Large trusses of single/semi-double blooms which are a blend of cream, yellow and pink. Repeat flowering. Bushy habit with shiny foliage. Height 0.9m spread 0.5m

**'Bliss'**

Fully double, creamy pink flowers with a darker apricot centre. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Dark green semi-glossy foliage. Disease resistant. Height 1m spread 0.6m

**'Blue for You'**

Blooms of a pretty lilac colour with a very strong fragrance. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Almost thornless. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'Bright as a Button'**

A Persica rose with single pale pink flowers with a magenta centre. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Disease resistant. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**'Brush Strokes'**

Blooms of red and yellow with a splash of pink, which increases as the flower ages. Good sized and shapely blooms in trusses. Very free flowering over a long season. Light fragrance. Height 0.9m spread 0.9m

**'Champagne Moment' (2006)**

Large blooms that are deep apricot in the centre, later paling to creamy white. Light fragrance. Continuous flowering. Extremely healthy. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Coral Gardens' (2025)**

Rose of the year 2026. Fully double blooms of coral-orange with pink undertones. Repeat flowering. Fruity fragrance. Disease resistant. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Disco Queen'**

Dark red, globular buds open to glowing orange/scarlet flowers in large clusters. Repeat flowering. Glossy mid-green foliage. Height 1m spread 0.8m

**'Ebb Tide'**

Medium sized, fully double blooms of rich velvety plum. Repeat flowering. Strong, spicy fragrance. Height 0.6m spread 0.5m

**'English Miss' (1977)**

Large sprays of light pink, camellia-like flowers. Good fragrance. Repeat flowering. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Eyes for You'**

Beautiful clusters of pale pink, almost white blooms which have an attractive mauve-purple blotch in the centre. Repeat flowering. Fragrant. Good disease resistance. Height 0.7m spread 0.6m

**'Eye of the Tiger'**

Single bi-coloured flowers, with golden petals and a burnt orange centre. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Good disease resistance. Height 0.7m spread 0.7m

**'Flower Bomb'**

Small, double, soft pink flowers produced in large sprays. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Strong, healthy growth. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'For Your Eyes Only' (2015)**

Blooms of dark pink with salmon and apricot tints with a distinctive dark eye and prominent stamens. Repeat flowering. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'For You with Love'**

Small clusters of double, frilled, orange flowers. Repeat flowering. Light delicate scent. Will tolerate poorer soils. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'Friends Forever'**

Fully double blooms of light pink produced in clusters. Repeat flowering. Strongly scented. Compact and bushy with glossy foliage. Height 0.7m spread 0.6m

**'Fruity Parfuma'**

Old-fashioned shaped flowers of deep pink. Powerful fragrance. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Golden Wedding' (1987)**

Medium sized, well-shaped flowers of golden yellow produced in clusters. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'Happy Golden Wedding'**

Shapely golden flowers produced in clusters. Repeat flowering. Well scented. Good disease resistance. Height 0.7m spread 0.6m

**'Helen's Rose'**

Well-shaped flowers of light baby pink. Repeat flowering. Sweetly scented. An easy to grow, strong and healthy bush. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Honey Bee Mine'**

Semi-double light-yellow flowers with an orange centre. Flat, open blooms appear in flushes throughout the season. Lightly scented. Good for pollinators. Height 1m spread 1m

**'Hot Chocolate' (2005)**

Novelty rose of the year 2006. Orange to brown shaded blooms in clusters on a bushy plant with dark glossy foliage. Continuous flowering. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'It's a Wonderful Life'**

Masses of coral and peach coloured flowers produced in clusters. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Good disease resistance. Height 1m spread 1m

**'Jester'**

Old-fashioned, fully double blooms of deep red. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Healthy, glossy foliage. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Joie de Vivre' (2011)**

Pale peach-pink blooms borne in clusters. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. A bushy, compact shrub with glossy foliage. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Lovely Perfuma'**

**'Margaret Merril' (1977)**

White flowers with a light pink sheen. Strong, sweet fragrance. Continuous flowering. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Meteor' (2023)**

Rose of the Year 2024. Double flowers of peachy-yellow with red edged petals. Very free flowering. Light, sweet scent. Healthy bushy growth. Height 0.7m spread 0.6m

**'Mind Games'**

Cerise and ivory striped blooms, with the ivory fading to pale pink with age. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Healthy, dark green foliage. Disease resistant. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Minerva'**

Ruffle-edged blooms of deep lilac with silver tones. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Healthy olive matt foliage. Height 1m spread 0.7m

**'Mountbatten' (1982)**

Huge clusters of rich golden yellow, pleasantly scented blooms. Repeat flowering. Bright glossy foliage on a sturdy shrub. Height 1.5m spread 0.9m

**'Mum in a Million'**

Large deep pink quartered blooms with a wonderful fragrance. Repeat flowering. Dark glossy foliage. Good for cutting. Height 1.0m spread 0.7m

**'My Dad'**

Fully double globular blooms of cerise red. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Healthy, glossy foliage. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'Natasha Richardson'**

Clusters of elegant baby-pink double flowers with a strong fragrance. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'New Beginnings'**

Double flowers of peach and apricot produced in clusters. Repeat flowering. Light fruity scent. Disease resistant. Height 0.7m spread 0.6m

**'Ol' Blue Eyes'**

A Persica hybrid with light cream blooms with a purple eye. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Attractive to bees. Height 1m spread 0.6m

**'Pearl'**

Fully double creamy pink flowers with a darker centre. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Healthy, glossy mid-green foliage. Height 1m spread 0.6m

**'Precious Memories'**

Pretty peachy-pink cup-shaped blooms. Repeat flowering. Moderately scented. Healthy, mid-green foliage. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Pretty Parfuma'**

Pastel-pink old-fashioned shaped flowers. Repeat flowering. Strong citrus fragrance. Healthy, disease resistant foliage. Height 1m spread 0.8m

**'Purple Magic'**

Semi-double purple flowers produced singly and in clusters. Repeat flowering. Strong, sweet fragrance. Disease resistant. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Rhapsody in Blue'**

Semi-double blooms which start purple and turn an inky blue with age. Free flowering. Sweet perfume. Rose of the Year 2003. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Sally Holmes' (1976)**

Huge trusses of soft pale pink to white flowers. Good scent. Perpetual flowering. Tolerates some shade. Can be grown in a pot. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Secret Parfuma'**

Medium-sized globular flowers of delicate light pink. Repeat flowering. Strong citrus fragrance. Healthy, disease resistant foliage. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'Sheila's Perfume' (1985)**

Showy bicolor flowers of pinky-mauve and yellow. An easy to grow plant. Repeat flowering. Strong perfume. Height 1m spread 0.8m

**'Super Trouper' (2009)**

Vivid, unfading orange blooms. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Dark-green, glossy foliage with good disease resistance. Height 0.8m spread 0.6m

**'Sweet Honey' (2015)**

Clusters of honey coloured, shapely blooms with a light fragrance. Repeat flowering. Healthy glossy foliage. Height 90cm spread 75cm

**'Sweet Jessica'**

Masses of medium-sized, cupped blooms of apricot-pink produced in small sprays. Repeat flowering. Good scent. Height 0.7m spread 0.5m

**'Together Forever'**

Strong, open formed flowers of deep orange, fading to shades of peach and pink with age. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Disease resistant. Height 1m spread 0.8m

**'Twilight Zone'**

Very double, old-fashioned flowers of deep, velvety purple. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance of clove and lemon. Height 1m spread 0.8m

**'Valentine Heart'**

Clusters of fully double, frilly, soft pink flowers on a strong and bushy shrub. Repeat flowering. Light sweet fragrance. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'You're Beautiful'**

Fully double striking blooms of bright pink. Repeat flowering. Mild fragrance. Good disease resistance. Rose of the Year 2013. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

***HYBRID TEA*****'Alexander'**

Bright vermillion-red, classically shaped flowers on quite a large shrub. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Anuschka'**

Magenta-pink old-fashioned flowers. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Healthy, glossy foliage. Height 1.1m spread 0.7m

**'Black Perfumella'**

Large, deep-red, cup-shaped blooms that appear almost black in a certain light. Repeat flowering. Intense fruity scent. Ideal as a cut flower. Height 1m spread 0.7m

**'Birthday Boy'**

Large blooms of deep lilac-magenta. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Enchantress'**

Old-fashioned, very double blooms of deep pink. Repeat flowering. Strong, fruity scent. Height 1m spread 0.8m

**'Good Ol' Dave'**

Honey coloured buds open to fiery orange, ruffled, blooms. Good fragrance. Repeat flowering. Height 1m spread 1m

**'Happy Ruby Wedding'**

Sweetly scented, bright ruby red flowers produced throughout the summer into the autumn. A strong, upright and vigorous growth habit. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Koko Loko'**

A uniquely coloured rose, bearing large coffee-tan flowers with a lilac tint. Repeat flowering. Pleasant perfume. Healthy, glossy foliage. Height 0.7m spread 0.6m

**'Love and Peace'**

Classic shaped flowers of yellow and pinky-red. Repeat flowering. Strong, fruity fragrance. A healthier version of its parent 'Peace'. Height 1.2m spread 0.8m

**'Mamma Mia'**

Exquisitely formed blooms of coral orange. Flowers freely from June to October. Highly fragrant. Good disease resistance. Height 0.9m spread 0.7m

**'Noblesse'**

Large, strongly scented blooms of magenta-red. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Winner of the Best Scented Rose award 2022. Height 1m spread 0.6m

**'Paperchase'**

Large, classically shaped blooms of pale lemon yellow. Repeat flowering. Strong citrus scent. Strong, upright habit. Ideal for cutting. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Remember'**

Softest blush pink, sometimes white flowers. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Dark green glossy foliage. Height 1m spread 0.8m

**'Remember Me'**

Deep copper blended with yellow blooms open from high pointed centres to become large, full and cupped. Repeat flowering. Height 0.7m spread 0.7m

**'Sally's Rose'**

Small, shapely blooms in shades of pale pink, peach and apricot. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Ideal for containers. Height 0.7m spread 0.6m

**'Scented Garden'**

Semi-double blooms of lemon yellow flushed with pink. Repeat flowering. Rich, strong fragrance. High disease resistance. Attractive to bees and pollinators. Height 1.5m spread 1.2m

**'Sentimental'**

A novel rose, flowers of cream with red stripes. Very good fragrance. Repeat flowering. Excellent for cutting. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'Sparkle'**

Vibrant, orange coloured hybrid tea shaped blooms. Repeat flowering. Strong fragrance. Strong upright stems, ideal for cutting. Height 0.6m spread 0.6m

**'Special Anniversary'**

Rich magenta-pink flowers on a neat, compact shrub. Repeat flowering. Heavily scented. Healthy, dark green foliage. Height 1.2m spread 0.9m

**'Sugar Moon'**

Classically shaped, pristine, pure white flowers. Repeat flowering. Strong citrus fragrance. Upright habit with strong stems that are ideal for cutting. Height 1m spread 0.7m

**'Twice in a Blue Moon'**

A very shapely lilac rose. Strong fragrance. Repeat flowering. Good disease resistance. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

**'You're My Everything'**

Rose of the Year 2025. Classic, double, cream flowers with dark pink at the edge of the petals. Repeat flowering. Fragrant. Disease resistant. Height 0.9m spread 0.6m

## **RAMBLER**

### **'Alberic Barbier' (1900)**

Fully double, creamy white flowers flushed yellow in bud, produced in clusters. Glossy, bright green foliage. Mainly summer flowering but will often repeat later in the season. Tolerates partial shade. Height 4.5m spread 3m

### **'American Pillar'**

Large trusses of single, carmine-pink flowers with a white eye and golden stamens. Single summer flowering. Shade tolerant. Height 5m Spread 3.5m

### **'City of York' (1945)**

Clusters of semi-double, creamy-white flowers with lemon centres. Repeat flowering. Strong, heady fragrance. Copes well with shade or on a North-facing wall. Height 5m spread 4m

### **'Felicite et Perpetue' (1827)**

Clusters of pink-tinted buds, opening to fully double creamy-white flowers. Well scented. Single summer flowering. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 4.5m spread 3m

### **'Francis Lester' (1946)**

Huge trusses of small, white single flowers, with blush pink tints at the edges. Strongly scented. Single summer flowering. Small red hips in autumn. Tolerates poor soil. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 4.5m spread 3m

### **'Francois Juranville' (1906)**

A clear pink rose of many petals with deeper shadings. Scented. Single summer flowering. Pliable and dense, with few thorns. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 5m spread 4.5m

### **'Ghislane de Feligonde' (1916)**

Clusters of fully double orange to yellow flowers. Good fragrance. Repeat flowering. Almost thornless and very healthy. Can be grown on a north wall. Height 2.5m spread 2.5m

### **'Little Rambler' (1997)**

Huge quantities of small, button-like, double blooms of blush pink. Repeat flowering. Strongly scented. Perfect for a small obelisk or arch. Height 3m spread 2m

### **'Manhattan Blue'**

Delicate, violet-pink blooms borne in generous sprays. Repeat flowering. Subtle but noticeable fragrance. Height 3.5m spread 2.5m

### **'Narrow Waters' (1883)**

Huge clusters of semi-double lilac pink flowers that fade to white. Good scent. Repeat flowering. Dark foliage. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 2.5m spread 1.8m

### **'Open Arms'**

A small patio rambling rose with clusters of shell pink semi-double flowers. Repeat flowering. Sweet fragrance. Healthy, dark green foliage. Height 2m spread 1m

**'Paul's Himalayan Musk' (1916)**

Small, double, lavender-pink flowers produced in drooping clusters. Single summer flowering. Slightly fragrant. Dark green foliage with hints of copper when young. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 6m spread 3.5m

**'Paul Transon' (1901)**

Medium sized double blooms of bright coppery pink. Repeat flowering. Fruity apple scent. Shiny dark green foliage. Height 3m spread 2.4m

**'Perennial Blush'**

Semi-double flowers of pearl pink, fading to white with age. Repeat flowering. Strong, sweet fragrance. Height 3m spread 2m

**'Phyllis Bide' (1923)**

Small rosette shaped flowers of salmon pink flushed with pale yellow. Repeat flowering. Sweet fragrance. Height 4.5m spread 3m

**'Rambling Rector'**

Large clusters of creamy white semi-double flowers, showing yellow stamens. Very scented. Single summer flowering. Small hips in autumn. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Can be grown into a tree. Height 6m spread 4.5m

**'Rambling Rosie' (2006)**

Bright red, semi-double blooms with an attractive white eye produced in clusters. Flowers freely all summer. Strong, glossy foliage. Slight scent. Will tolerate a small amount of shade. Height 3.5m spread 2.4m

**'Super Dorothy'**

Small, double, mid-pink blooms held in clusters. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented.

**'Super Excelsa'**

Large clusters of carmine-crimson flowers with white flecks. Petals become more purple with age. Repeat flowering. Lightly scented. Height 3m spread 2m

## ***RUGOSA***

**'Rosa Rugosa'**

Bright fuschia-coloured flowers with contrasting yellow stamens. Repeat flowering. Strong Old Rose scent. Very large, round, red hips. Tolerates poor soil conditions. Height 2m spread 2m

**'Rosa Rugosa Alba' (1870)**

Silky textured pure-white single flowers, showing golden stamens, followed by orange-red hips. Very fragrant. Continuous flowering. Slightly glossy foliage. Excellent hedging or woodland planting. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.8m

**'Rosaie de l'Hay' (1901)**

Large semi-double crimson-purple flowers, opening loosely flat. Strongly scented. Repeat flowering. Only occasionally sets fruit, but very good autumn foliage. Good for hedging. Tolerates poor soil and some shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m

## ***SPECIES***

**'Rosa rubrifolia' (glauca) (1830)**

Clusters of small mauve-pink flowers, producing oval, red hips in autumn. Slight fragrance. Single summer flowering. Can be planted in a northerly aspect. Good autumn colour. Can be planted as hedging or in woodland. Tolerates poor soil and shade. Height 1.8m spread 1.5m
